

WHAT TO BRING

Remembering that it will be 10 – 15 degrees cooler in the mountains, and a possibility for snow and snow sports; please be prepared for the cold. The Lodge should be comfortable and warm once we get situated but, we will be outside at times too.

- **BIBLE**
- Note book, pen

- Toiletries
- Towels (at least two)
- Bag Lunch for Friday or money to buy food – Truck Stop fast food
- Money for fast food on the way home Sunday, we will eat there before we leave.
- Modest swimwear and Dark colored T shirt for hot tubs. Guys in one Girls in the other.
- Guitar, jimbay
- Sleeping bags; are not required but may be wanted at night.
- Gloves or Mittens (two pairs, in case one gets wet)
- Long Underwear (shirt and pants), preferably moisture wicking
- Turtleneck
- Sweater or fleece
- Winter Socks (ski socks or fleece sock), plus an extra pair
- Winter Pants (insulated and waterproof)
- Winter Jacket (insulated and waterproof)
- Scarf (to keep your neck warm)
- Hat, Headband
- Sunglasses
- **Tip:** If you dress in layers, you can always remove a layer if you get too hot.

1. Pack your clothing. To make sure that you don't forget anything, pack your clothing in the order that you usually wear them. Pack your base layer (your long underwear). Then pack your mid layer (a sweater or turtleneck). Don't forget your insulating layer (a fleece jacket), and make sure you pack your winter jacket and pants.
2. Pack your accessories. First, pack your warm socks - bring at least two pairs. Bring your hat, a pair of gloves or mittens, a neck scarf, and sunglasses.
3. Pack the clothing that you plan on wearing when you're not outside. While what clothing you pack depends on your preferences (MODEST OF COURSE), packing warm clothing is always a good idea. However, don't forget a good pair of boots! You may have to do a lot of walking, and you want your feet to be stable on slush or ice plus, stay warm.
4. Remember space in the vehicles will be limited so, consolidate as much as possible.

We will be responsible for preparing our own meals, clean up and condition of the Lodges.

We will be separated in the two Lodges; Males in one, Females in the other.

This will be a time for fellowship and fun but, our focus will be on God, His Word and Worship.

We are representing our Families, Churches, and Jesus Christ, let's conduct ourselves as if they were all with us.
